The ABES-R2 assesses 10 areas of adaptive skills grouped under the three adaptive behavior domains : Conceptual, Social, and Practical Skills.

This questionnaire is :

- Used with people from ages 15 to Adult
- Used in planning student's IEP & IAP
- Assesses which work supports are needed and the amount of supports required
- Matches a person's work competency with a vocational program level

A person's work adjustment and support needs are evaluated in four domains and a composite or global score:

- Work Habits/Attitudes
- Interpersonal Relations
- Cognitive Skills
- Work Performance Skills
- Broad Work Adjustment

The booklet contains 63 items and can be administered and scored in 20 minutes.

The Quebec Adaptive Behavior Scale (QABS) is a questionnaire that permits the assessment of adaptive behaviors of individuals presenting intellectual limitations. The QABS assessment is valid for persons aged 3 years and older. This instrument allows for either a criterion or normative classification of the individual's level of functioning pertaining to adaptive behaviors.

The Scale of Self-Determination LARIDI (Teen and adult version)
Is an evaluation tool assessing the degree of self-determination designed for people with intellectual disabilities.

Two objectives are pursued:

- Provide students with learning disabilities, intellectual difficulties to identify their strengths and limits with respect to self-determination.

•Provide a research tool allowing the analysis of the relationship between self-determination and some factors likely to promote or impede self-determination.
